

Chamber Music Concerts Langenthal

Short portrait

History

The Chamber Music Concerts Langenthal was founded in 1946. Since then, five chamber music concerts have been held every year (October to March). The series aims to bring internationally renowned performers to Langenthal, to enable top Swiss ensembles to perform in their own country, and to give upcoming artists who have proved themselves at competitions the chance to play in front of a demanding audience. The concerts take place in the acoustically good baroque hall of the "Bären" in Langenthal. The hall has about 240 seats. The series is directed by Hanspeter von Flüe (general management, since 2011), Eva Lüthi (artistic management, since 2015) and Marianne von Flüe Fleck (administration management, since 2008) and enjoys a warm response from its audience.
